Her oldest daughter is a local real estate broker and her youngest daughter attends school in Ukiah Unified School District. She is also a proud grandmother and loves to spend time with her granddaughters. Mulheren served on many boards and commissions while running a licensed Insurance Agency for ten years. Mulheren was first elected to the Ukiah City Council in 2014, and re-elected again in 2018 and served as the Mayor for the City of Ukiah in 2019.

In 2019 Mulheren announced that she was running for the Second District Supervisor seat to bring her connection and dedication to the County. She is passionate about economic development, health and human services and serving her community. Mulheren was elected to the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors in 2020 and started in her role as the Second District Supervisor in January of 2021. She was re-elected to the Board in November of 2024 and renewed her Oath in January of 2025.
