To the Registered Voters on the Mendocino County South Coast:

SOUTH COAST AREA VOTERS – The Elections Office needs Poll Workers for the Point Arena Polling Place. For the Point Arena Polling Place to stay open, the Election's Office needs members of the public who are registered voters to volunteer as Poll Workers.

Staff needed include an Inspector and at least 2 half-time Clerks for Election Day, June 2, 2026

Being an Inspector, involves attending a training (on Thursday, May 28, 2026, at the Veterans Hall in Point Arena) before Election Day, and receiving the ADA Voting machine, poll supplies and meeting the poll workers. The Inspector contacts the Polling Location to pick up a key, arranges for set up the day before the election with the workers at the location. On Election Day the Inspector oversees the polling site, assists voters and other workers, helping voters and poll workers throughout the day and evening. After polls close, the Inspector packs supplies and equipment for the runners to pick up and transport to Ukiah.

Polls are open on Election Day, June 2, 2026, from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm.

If you are interested in working at a polling place, please call the Elections Office at 707 234-6808, or email us at mcvotes@mendocinocounty.gov. We would love to speak with you and send you some additional information. The County pays a small stipend to Election Day Workers.

The County would like to keep this polling place open. If we cannot find people willing to work at polling places, the County may be forced to close polling places with insufficient staff.
