¹ After the jury split in favor of guilt and following several continuances, the defendant ultimately admitted a cannabis-related driving offense (along with a refusal allegation and a drug-related driving with a minor in the vehicle allegation) that counts as a DUI prior. The defendant now has a three alcohol or drug-related driving convictions in the last two years. Should get arrested for the same conduct anytime in the next eight years, he will be facing a felony charge. Accordingly, this favorable outcome is placed in the success column.

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² A retrial of this defendant before a new panel of jurors is scheduled for February 2, 2026.

³ After the jury split heavily in favor of conviction, the defendant admitted criminal responsibility by pleading no contest plea on October 14, 2025 to a misdemeanor violation of Vehicle Code section 23103, punishable pursuant to Vehicle Code section 23013.5 (often referred to as a “wet reckless” conviction). A wet reckless conviction counts as a DUI prior for purposes of enhancing the penalties for any future DUI conviction and has similar terms of court probation. Accordingly, this outcome is placed in the **success** column.

⁴ With two of the three felony charges resolved by the jury, the remaining count is pending retrial before a new jury on July 27, 2026.
